COWICHAN – On Saturday, March 19th Cowichan Elder Care Co-op and MP Alistair MacGregor will cohost a town hall for Embrace Aging Month. This is a free event but attendees are encouraged to bring a share plate. Tea and coffee will be provided.

Since 2006, the Eldercare Foundation, through their Embrace Aging initiative, has aimed to connect older adults and their families to the wealth of resources available to help navigate the journey of aging. For more information on this year's schedule, go to <u>www.embraceaging.org</u>.

This year the Cowichan Elder Care Co-op will co-host a Town Hall open to the public at the Duncan United Church on Saturday, March 19th from 1pm – 4pm. Speakers will include Roger Hart and Hilary Abbott giving an update from the Cowichan Elder Care Co-op, Moira Hauk of Coastal Community Credit Union speaking about the Registered Education Savings Plan and other financial programs of interest to seniors while local MP Alistair MacGregor will be discussing his role as the NDP's Seniors Critic.

The Cowichan Elder Care Co-op (CECC) is a Social Service Co-op owned by seniors and managed by seniors to provide services for seniors, as an alternative to private or public care organizations. The CECC was developed with the support of the Social Development Partnerships Program of the Government of Canada, the Vancouver Foundation, and the B.C. Co operative Association. The Co-op also received a generous donation of seed funding from Coastal Community Credit Union as part of its Building Healthier Communities Fund.
